RECYCLING BINS AT STATION PARADE

Please be aware that the bring bank recycling site at Station Parade, East Horsley is being closed permanently from w/c 22 January 2024. The reason, we are told, is that everything currently recycled at the recycling point can now be collected through the usual kerbside recycling collection. Charity recycling collection banks (which are not situated at the Council's allocated sites), will remain across the borough to offer a separate service. DO YOU HAVE **RIPARIAN RESPONSIBILITIES?**

Recent months have seen unprecedented rainfall. Now, more than ever, it is important that we all do our bit to help keep our village roads free from floodwaters, and that includes keeping our ditches and culverts clear to allow surface water to drain away quickly and effectively. If you own land alongside a watercourse, you are legally termed a riparian owner. Watercourses include natural or artificial channels, such as rivers, streams, ditches and culverts (an underground covered channel or pipe). As a riparian owner you have the responsibility for maintenance and clearance of these watercourses. For more information, please click on the link Riparian Ownership.
