West Horsley Parish Council

What are we consulting on?

Following a request from West Horsley Parish Council, Guildford Borough Council is now consulting the public on:

- (1) whether the number of councillors on West Horsley Parish Council should increase from nine (9) to eleven (11);
- (2) whether there should be any change to the year in which elections to the parish council are held (currently every four years with next elections due in May 2023); and
- (3) whether West Horsley Parish Council should be divided into wards for the purpose of electing parish councillors and, if so, the name, number and boundaries of any such wards, and the number of parish councillors to be elected for such wards.

In relation to (2) above, the Borough Council proposes that no change be made as parish elections currently take place at the same time as borough council elections and elections to other parish councils in the borough.

In relation to (3) above, the Borough Council proposes that West Horsley Parish Council should remain unwarded. The Parish Council supports these proposals.
